#### 1.3 SCOPE OF WORK

Cleaning, painting, and repair of the Chenocetah 1.5 million gallon standpipe tank.

- The standpipe is welded steel, has a diameter of 54-feet, and a height of 89-feet.

- Exterior rehabilitation includes but not limited to pressure washing, SSPC#2 spot repairs, spot pine, and topcoat.

- Interior rehabilitation includes but not limited to SP10 wet, SP12 dry, 2-part epoxy paint interior.

- No containment will be required

### 1.5 CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATIONS

Offerors must complete the Qualifications of Offeror (Section 00470) in order to be evaluated for award of the Contract. Refer to the specific requirements outlined in the referenced Section.

Offerors must demonstrate the following minimum qualifications in order for the proposal to be considered:

- A. Successful rehabilitation of a minimum of five (5) water tanks equal to or greater than 1.0 MG in the last three (3) years. Provide the address and Owner contact information and the installation date for each.
- B. Successfully performed similar work for a minimum of three (3) years under their current business entity name.

## 1.6 BONDS

Bids shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified cashier's check in an amount not less than 10% of the base bid. All bonds shall be by a surety company licensed in Georgia with an "A" minimum rating of performance and a financial strength of at least five (5) times the contract price as listed in the most current publication of "Best's Key Rating Guide Property Liability". Performance and Payment Bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price shall be required of the successful bidder if contract is awarded. Each Bond shall be accompanied by a "Power of Attorney" authorizing the attorney-in-fact to bind the surety and certified to include the date of the bond.
