- 1. Meeting called to order by Brent Cody, seconded by Heath Barret, all in favor.
- 2. Financials:
  - a. Operating- \$2,597.54
  - b. Façade- \$9,900.24
  - c. Savings- \$25.03
- 3. Old Business
  - a. Committees
    - i. **Marketing + Promotional** After Big Red Apple has passed Alex Michelle and Noah Hamil are going to look back at potentially updating the folder given to new businesses that move into downtown.
    - ii. Economic Development- The railroad crossing project was completed the previous week and it's a major improvement.
       We got the \$1 million grant for the amphitheater.

A pedestrian bridge over the railroad tracks has been proposed and is in the works, looking for funding currently.

- b. Work Plan Progress
  - i. Beautification- Still looking into the best options for getting the plant hangars.
  - Placemaking- \$1000 to purchase a gallon of the hydrophobic, it has been ordered.
    Determined that \$200 is a good start for stencils, at \$20 a stencil that comes out to 10 stencils. If we decide we want more we can revaluate.
- c. Potential vacancies on the board
  - i. Some members have decided to step down from the board due to reasons and other priorities. As soon as Main Street Manager Noah Hamil receives an official letter of resignation with a named replacement for the vacancy they will remain on the board
- d. Potential Fundraisers
