THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE TO THE BEST OF MY ABILITY,
THAT IN THE ENACTMENT AND REVISION OF ALL LEGISLATION
I WILL HAVE DUE REGARDS FOR THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CORNELIA
THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA,
AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ; AND I DO FUTHER AWARE THAT
I HAVE NOT , EITHER IN THE GENERAL ELECTION OR PRIMARY
IN WHICH I WAS A CANIDATE , DIRECTALLY OR INDIRECTLY
EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED ANY PROMISES OF SUPPORT TO ANY
PERSON FOR ANY OFFICE IN THE GOVERMENT OF THE CITY OF
CORNELIA , NOR HAVE I INFLUENCED MY ELECTION BY THE UNLAWFUL
USE OF MONEY OR OTHER THINGS OF VALUE, OR BY THE USE OF
INTOXICATING LIQUOR. I DO FUTHER SWARE THAT I WILL NOT
KNOWINGLY PERMIT ANY PERSON TO A POSITION IN THE CITY
GOVERMENT OR ON THE PASSAGE OR ADOPTION OF ANY ORDANANCE
BEFORE THE COMMISSIONERS , TO BE INFLUENCED BY FAVORS,
AFFECTION, REWARD OR THE HOPE THEREOF, BUT THAT IN ALL
PERTAINING TO MY OFFICE I WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE CONVICTION
AS TO THE PUBLIC GOOD.
