

NOVEMBER 7, 1940

AT THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING HELD ON THE ABOVE DATE , ALL COMMISSIONERS WERE PRESENT, MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND APPROVED.

KENIMER MADE THE MOTION THAT B. J. CASH, WATER WORKS SUPT. BE GIVEN PERMISSION TO MOVE THE LOG HOUSE AT THE OLD C.C.C. CAMP SITE TO THE WATER WORKS PLANT. CRAWFORD SECONDED AND WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

CRAWFORD MADE THE MOTION FOR CITY MANAGER, CITY AT ORNEY AND MAYOR TO GET EASEMENTS FROM PROPERTY OWNERS FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, KENIMER SECONDED AND WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

CRAWFORD MADE THE MOTION THAT CITY MANGER AND MAYOR SEE HOW MUCH CEMENT IT WOULD TAKE TO EXTEND CURBING FROM COCA COLA PLANT TO INTERSECTION WITH LOWER END OF CLAKRESVILLE STREET, KENIMER SECONDED AND WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

CRAWFORD MADE THE MOTION THAT S. F. WOOD BE REIMBURSED ON CHECK HE ISSUED TO WALDRUP, KENIMER SECONDED AND WAS UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

MEETING ADJOURNED AT THE CALL OF THE MAYOR.

AT A CALL MEETING HELD ON THE ABOVE DATE ALL COMMISSIONERS WERE PRESENT, EXCEPT A. L. CRAWFORD.

KENIMER MADE THE MOTION TO ADOPT RESOLUTION GIVING MRS. W. T. FOSTER THE RIGHT TO USE PORTION OF SAID LAND, THAT WAS BOUGHT FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, FOR CULTIVATION- ANOTHER RESOLUTION TO PAY R. C. SCOTT, J.W.D. AND INEZ SMITH AND R. L. ADDINGTON FOR LAND PURCHASED FROM SAME FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT. WOOD SECONDED.

KENIMER MADE THE MOTION THAT SEC'Y BE INSTRUCTED TO LET ALL BONDING HOUSES IN ATLANTA AND LOCAL PEOPLE KNOW THAT THE CITY OF CORNELIA WAS OFFERING FOR SALE THE FOLLOWING BONDS:

\$10,000 SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT BONDS  
\$ 2,000 WATER WORKS BONDS

WOOD SECONDED.
